## **SURFACE PREPARATION:**

Proper surface preparation is the most important variable in determining the service life of a coating. For best results, all surfaces must be clean, dry and sound. Wash contaminated surfaces thoroughly to remove dirt, grease, oil, water-soluble material, loose paint and powdery substances. Fix cracks and holes with spackling compound and allow spackle to dry prior to application of any paint film. Glossy surfaces must be dulled with sandpaper or de-glossing solution. Bare wood must be primed with enamel undercoat. Bare metal must be primed with Van Sickle° Equipment Enamel Primer. Previously painted surfaces must be properly prepared, then apply one or two coats of Van Sickle° Interior Latex Ceiling Magic<sup>™</sup> Paint.

## **APPLICATION:**

Apply by nylon or polyester brush, roller or spray. Apply as is from the container. Pay special attention to keep a wet edge when painting large, open rooms and "cross roll" at 90° angles when applying more than one coat. Before and during use stir the paint thoroughly from the bottom of the can with an upward motion, scraping the bottom to avoid pigment settling. Do not add oil-based products or thinners to this product.

### **ENVIRONMENTAL VARIABLES:**

Apply only when surface and air temperatures are between 50° and 90°F. Cool, wet, humid or over-applied coatings can greatly decrease a thorough cure and interfere with proper film formation. Always allow applied coat to dry before applying subsequent coats.

#### **Dry-Times:**

Drying time for this product will be approximately 1 hour to touch, and may be recoated after 4 hours under ideal drying conditions.

### **CLEAN-UP**:

Clean up all tools and equipment with warm, soapy water before paint dries.
