1. WALL COLOR:

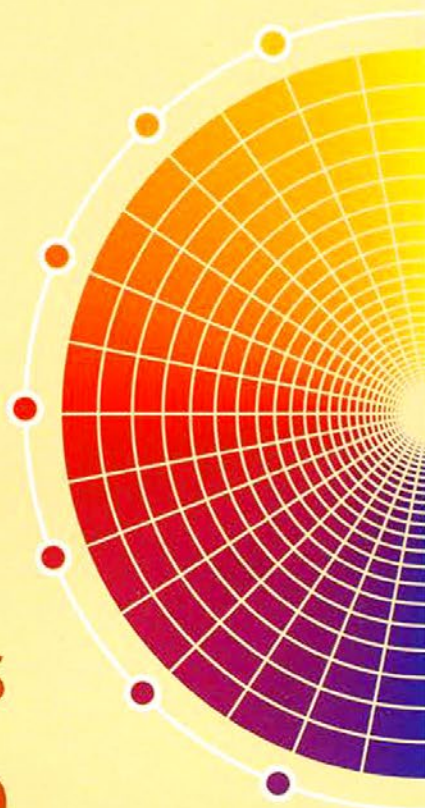
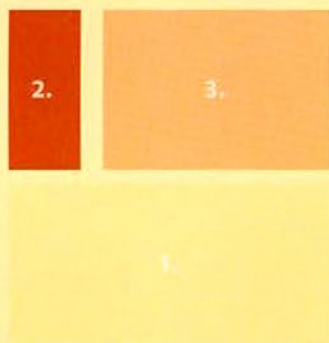
You can't go wrong selecting a light or medium color for the main wall color of the room. You can fine tune your selection with the help of our Colorizer in store color selector.

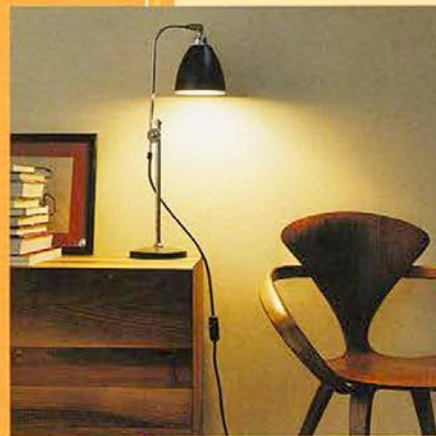
3. ACCENT COLOR:
